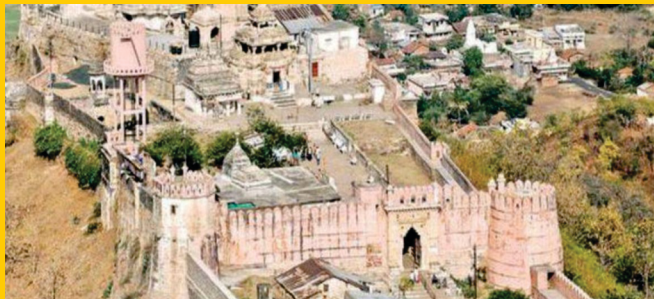
ABOUT VENUE COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE, DR. PDKV, NAGPUR, MAHARASHTRA:

HISTORICAL & CULTURAL SIDE:

1. Dekshabhumi:

The stupa, also called Dhamma Chakra, is a magnificent architectural structure that can hold more than 5,000 people. The Deekshabhumi, a Buddhist holy monument, is one of India's most well-known Buddhist pilgrimage centers.



2. Ramtek Temple:

Ramtek, located near Nagpur in Maharashtra, is primarily famous for its ancient hilltop Ram Temple (Gad Mandir) where Lord Ram is believed to have rested during his exile, attracting pilgrims. It is also renowned as the place where the poet Kalidasa composed Meghaduta, with the scenic Khindsi Lake and historical fort.

3. Dragon Palace:

The Dragon Palace, one of India's most famous Buddhist temples, is a popular Buddhist religious tourist destination in Nagpur. It has remarkable architecture and is located in Kamptee, a municipal council in the city. It is seen as a symbol of Indo-Japanese friendship.



Pench Tiger Reserve:

Pench Tiger Reserve, located about 50-70 km from Nagpur, Maharashtra, is a premier wildlife destination spread over 742 sq km, famous for its high tiger density, biodiversity, and as the inspiration for Rudyard Kipling's "The Jungle Book". It is easily accessible via road from Nagpur and features popular entry gates such as Khursapar and Koltimara for jeep safaris.
